Bird Conservation Funding Initiative

- \$22 million increase for requested programs.
- \$1 million for NMBCA
- \$3 million for Migratory Bird Joint Ventures
- \$4 million for invasive species control
- \$8 million for NAWCA and
- \$6 million for State and Tribal Wildlife Grants
- State of the Birds Funding for Hawaii protected and language encouraging agencies to reduce window collisions.



Reducing Window Collisions

- Educating Architects and Universities
